The products are rich in organic ALOE VERA and HEMP OIL, which both have excellent properties for the skin. The hemp oil especially works on a cellular level to repair damaged skin.

The addition of organic essential oils has a mild anti bacterial effect, as well as adding a completely natural aroma.

What exactly is 'Aerobic Oxygen'? Here's what the experts say

"In Aerobic Oxygen we have a process to stabilize many oxygen molecules to a sodium chloride [table salt] molecule, and it will remain stable in that liquid form. Aerobic Oxygen is in a stable form and acts as a very efficient antioxidant. It will also attach itself to and destroy toxins that should not be in the body. Oxygen will destroy any type of anaerobic infectious bacteria."

And what about ethylexywhatsit? Well, ethylexyglycerin is basically vegetable glycerin that has been slightly altered in the laboratory, helping to make sure that the deodorant sticks together as well as providing mild anti-bacterial and preservative qualities.

Are the products vegan? Absolutely, 100%, as are all Yaoh products.

Have they been tested on animals? No, none of our products have. The factory that makes our deodorants started in the late 90's and has never used animal testing or ingredients that have been tested on animals.

Are they any good? Do they work? Well, we tested them on some particularly smelly people as it happens, and they loved them! (We won't go into detail here). People who have sensitive skin and don't get on with chemical ingredients tend to like them a lot too, as they don't appear to irritate the skin in the same way.
